  Access Safe Drinking Water Program.
  - Every month Woodland welcomes volunteers such as Family Physicians, Nurses, Dentist, Lab Technicians, Med Students, Audiologist, Engineers, Teachers, Social Workers, Corporate teams, Rotary Clubs, Rotaract, Interact, High Schools and Non- Medical volunteers.
- 2. Duration and cost of the trip:
  - Each team needs a minimum of 8 individuals registered.
  - The cost for 7 days (1 week) is \$1,150.00 to Puerto Rico per person. (includes in-country expenses: meals, lodging (double room) ground transportation, translators, program administration expenses, 2 t-shirts) Bi-lingual volunteers are encouraged to participate. This cost do not include airplane ticket.
  - Volunteers are responsible for purchasing their own roundtrip airplane ticket from the U.S. to Puerto Rico. Volunteers will share a hotel double room, if single room is requested will increase a cost\*

\*Please do not purchase your airplane ticket until approved by team coordinator.

## **3.** Trip activities include:

- Water filter distribution, sanitation campaigns, nutrition training, home assistance projects.
- Volunteer work at the community garden
- Home improvements -paint, English/computer classes and other activities at the school or in the community.
